

### THE PROJECT:

The Stowe Street Alley Project, also known as Jack's Alley, will reclaim and makeover an alley that is central to our historic downtown district creating a lively, public space that is attractive and engaging for the community. Jack Carter, the original owner of the Stowe Street Emporium at 23 Stowe Street, was passionate about reclaiming the Stowe Street Alley and had dreamt about it for over 20 years. He was a key member of the planning committee until he died unexpectedly in June 2021.


The Alley Project has three phases:

- Installation of a new surface made from pavers and bricks, creating space for art demonstrations and performances, an inground garden bed, a structure over the cellar stairway to 23 Stowe Street and screening for the utilities.
- 2. Functional and artistic streetscape features such as benches, trash/recycling, security assets, and additional landscaping.
- 3. Integrated art components, including lighting and an entranceway.

The brick pavers will be installed Spring 2023 - with the help of donors such as you!
